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Guidelines for Detached Buildings, Pools, Fences, Decks and Docks

- 1. Detached buildings must be constructed of brick or stucco or materials to match the main house. If the building is proposed after construction of the main home, revised site and architectural plans are required.
- 2. Swimming pools must be specifically approved in writing by the ACC; plans must show location on the site plan, any retaining walls, and materials. Pool enclosures must be within the setback requirements and shown on the site plan. Screen or fence enclosure design must be submitted for approval.
- 3. Fences, decks, and docks:

Fence, deck, and dock design, construction materials, and setbacks must be shown on site plan, be submitted in writing, and be approved by ACC prior to construction.

No chain link or welded wire fencing will be permitted. Approved fencing materials are brick, stucco, aluminum or wood. Sample or photographs may be requested.

Wood privacy or picket fences must have decorative or scalloped tops with finished side facing out.

Please be aware any modifications to the approved documents and plans (exterior elevations, material changes or site location modifications) will require the plans to be resubmitted for a secondary approval. Construction of the modified plans is not to begin until resubmitted plans have been approved, even though the proper building permits from the county may have been previously obtained.

Reminder: No dwelling, building, outbuilding, garage, storage building, barn, fence, wall or other structure shall be commenced, erected or maintained upon the properties. Nor shall any exterior addition to, or changes or alteration therein, be made until the plans specifications, showing the nature, kind, shape, height, materials and location of the alterations have been submitted to and approved in writing as to the harmony of the external design and location in relation to surrounding structures and topography.
